

## ANNUAL INFORMATION REPORT

### CHERRY HILLS CITY METROPOLITAN DISTRICT

Pursuant to Section VIII of the Service Plan approved by the City of Aurora, Colorado on July 24, 2006.

- 1. Boundary changes made or proposed to the District's boundary as of December 31 of the prior year.** There were no boundary changes made or proposed during 2021.
- 2. Intergovernmental Agreements with other governmental entities, either entered into or proposed, as of December 31 of the prior year.**

**City of Aurora ("City")**

*Intergovernmental Agreement* dated February 21, 2008; describes the rights and responsibilities of the District regarding operation and ownership of public facilities, agreements relative to certain regional improvements and continued oversight by the City.

- 3. Copies of the District's rules and regulations, if any, as of December 31, of the prior year.** The District has not adopted any rules and regulations.
- 4. A summary of any litigation which involves the District Public Improvements as of December 31 of the prior year.** In October 2021, the District was served with a Notice, Claim and Summons to Appear for Trial which was filed in the Arapahoe County Small Claims Court. The complaint alleges the plaintiff sustained damages to landscaping as well as pain and suffering relative to a trash can located near the plaintiff's unit. The trial was held on June 15, 2022, where the District was dismissed from the case. The plaintiff has since appealed the case to the Arapahoe County District Court. The District disputes the claims alleged and denies liability for the plaintiff's alleged damages.
- 5. Status of the District's construction of the Public Improvements as of December 31 for the prior year.** No capital improvements were constructed by the District in 2021.
- 6. A list of all facilities and improvements constructed by the District that have been dedicated to and accepted by the City as of December 31 of the prior year.** There have been no facilities or improvements constructed by the District dedicated to and accepted by the City as of December 31, 2021.
- 7. The assessed valuation of the District for the current year.** The District's 2021 assessed valuation from Arapahoe County was \$2,509,999.
- 8. Current year budget including a description of the Public Improvements to be constructed in such year.** A copy of the 2022 budget is attached hereto. No public improvements are anticipated to be constructed by the District in 2022.
- 9. Audit for the District's financial statements, for the year ending December 31 of the previous year, prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles or audit exemption, if applicable.** A copy of the Audit for 2021 will be supplied upon completion.

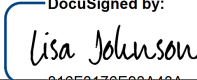

**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE SUMS OF MONEY**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF CHERRY HILLS CITY METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, ARAPAHOE COUNTY, COLORADO, PURSUANT TO SECTION 29-1-108, C.R.S., SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR EACH FUND, ADOPTING A BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY FOR THE BUDGET YEAR 2022**

A. The Board of Directors of Cherry Hills City Metropolitan District (the “**District**”) has appointed Simmons & Wheeler, P.C. to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said governing body at the proper time.

B. Simmons & Wheeler, P.C. has submitted a proposed budget to this governing body by October 15, 2021 for its consideration.

C. Upon due and proper notice, published or posted in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, a public hearing was held on December 1, 2021, and interested taxpayers were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget.

D. The budget has been prepared to comply with all terms, limitations and exemptions, including, but not limited to, reserve transfers and expenditure exemptions, under Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution (“**TABOR**”) and other laws or obligations which are applicable to or binding upon the District.

E. Whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

F. The Board of Directors has made provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget.

G. It is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, thereby establishing a limitation on expenditures for the operations of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF CHERRY HILLS CITY METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, ARAPAHOE COUNTY, COLORADO:

1. The budget, as submitted, amended, and summarized by fund, is hereby approved and adopted as the budget of the District for the year stated above.

2. The budget is hereby approved and adopted, shall be certified by the Secretary of the District to all appropriate agencies and is made a part of the public records of the District.

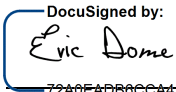

**BUDGET MESSAGE**

Attached please find a copy of the adopted 2022 budget for Cherry Hills City Metropolitan District.

The Cherry Hills City Metropolitan District has adopted a budget for three funds, a General Fund to provide for general operating expenditures and transfers to the Debt Service Fund; a Capital Projects Fund to provide for payment of the estimated infrastructure costs to be built for the benefit of the district; and a Debt Service Fund to provide for payments on the 2020 general obligation bonds.

The district's accountants have utilized the modified accrual basis of accounting and the budget has been adopted after proper postings, publications and public hearing.

The primary source of revenue for the district in 2022 will be property tax revenue. For 2022, the district intends to impose a 73.777 mill levy on property within the district, of which 18.113 will be dedicated to the General Fund, and 55.664 mills will be dedicated to the Debt Service Fund. 1.113 mills of the 18.113 general fund mills are restricted for regional improvements per an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Aurora.

**RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CHERRY HILLS CITY METROPOLITAN DISTRICT  
LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES, PURSUANT TO SECTION 39-1-111,  
C.R.S., FOR THE YEAR 2021, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT  
FOR THE 2022 BUDGET YEAR**

A. The Board of Directors of the Cherry Hills City Metropolitan District (the “**District**”) has adopted an annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 1, 2021.

B. The adopted budget is attached as Exhibit A to the Resolution of the Board of Directors of the District to Adopt Budget and Appropriate Sums of Money, and such budget is incorporated herein by this reference.

C. The amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general fund expenses from property tax revenue is identified in the budget.

D. The amount of money necessary to balance the budget for debt service fund expenses from property tax revenue is identified in the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 39-1-111(5) and 39-5-128(1), C.R.S., BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cherry Hills City Metropolitan District, Arapahoe County, Colorado, that:

1. For the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the District during the 2022 budget year, the District determined to levy mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District, as set forth in the budget, to raise the required revenue.

2. That for the purpose of meeting all debt retirement expenses of the District during the 2022 budget year, the District determined to levy mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District, as set forth in the budget, to raise the required revenue.

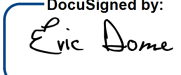
3. That for the purpose of meeting all contractual obligation expenses of the District during the 2022 budget year, the District determined to levy mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District, as set forth in the budget, to raise the required revenue.

4. That the Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the Board of County Commissioners of Arapahoe County, Colorado, the mill levies for the District as set forth in the District’s Certification of Mill Levies, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by reference, recalculated as needed upon receipt of the final certification of valuation from the County Assessor in order to comply with any applicable revenue and other budgetary limits.
